REQUIREMENTS FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE APPLICATION IN FRIO COUNTY

1. **BOTH** applicants must appear before the clerk.
2. **BOTH** applicants must submit proof of age and identify by certified copy of the applicant's birth certificate, driver's license or document issued by the state or another state, the United States or a foreign government. (Section 2.005 Texas Family Code).
3. **BOTH** applicants are required to present their social security card. (if applicable).
4. The fee for a marriage license is \$82. Cash, Checks, Money Orders, Credit and Debit cards are accepted.
5. The general age requirement to apply for a marriage license in the State of Texas is **eighteen (18)**. Applicants 16 and 17 **ONLY**, who wish to apply for a marriage license must submit a completed [**"PARENTAL CONSENT TO MARRIAGE"**](#) form. (Section 2.101 Texas Family Code).
6. If a marriage ceremony has not been conducted before the 90th day after the date the license was issued, the marriage license expires. (Section 2.201 Texas Family Code). Normally the marriage ceremony may not take place during the 72 hour period immediately following the issuance of the marriage license.
7. The 72 hour waiting period does not apply to an applicant who meets one of the following criteria:
 - A. The applicant is active duty military
 - B. The applicants complete a "TWOGETHER IN TEXAS" premarital education course approved by the State of Texas, and PROVIDES the marital education course completion certificate to the County Clerk.
 - C. The applicants obtain a signature from the County Judge.
8. It is the applicant's responsibility to set up the appointment with the person who is conducting the marriage ceremony.
