## FRIO COUNTY OUTDOOR BURN PROCEDURES DURING A BURN BAN

ALL BURNING MUST BE DONE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF FRIO COUNTY (BURNS ARE NOT ALLOWED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ANY MUNICIPALITY)

All burns must follow TCEQ Outdoor Burn Regulations for Texas and Frio County.

All burns other than these Exceptions (Firefighter Training, Fires for Cooking and Domestic Waste Burning) <u>MUST</u> be permitted through the Frio County Judge's Office during a BURN BAN.

#### **Exceptions:**

- Firefighter Training-must be conducted by a Fire Department.
- **Domestic Waste**-household trash or rubbish may be burned. To qualify for this exception the waste must:
  - o Come from a property that is
    - Designed for and used exclusively as a private residence, housing not more than 3 families
  - o Be burned on the property where is produced. Examples:
    - Kitchen garbage, untreated lumber, cardboard boxes, packaging, clothing, grass, leaves and branch trimmings
  - Be burned in a barrel with a means of controlling sparks and embers from leaving the barrel (screen or grate), with a way of controlling and preventing the fire from spreading
  - o Be monitored during burning by an adult with a means of extinguishing the fire.
- Cooking Fires-should be done using caution, with a means of controlling and keeping
  the fire from spreading. Be monitored during burning by an adult with a means of
  extinguishing the fire as required by the Outdoor Burning Regulations of Texas.

All other burns will be subject to the permitting process.

#### To receive a permit to burn:

Come to the Frio County Judge's office located in the Frio County Courthouse at 500 E. San Antonio St., Pearsall. Office hours are 8:00 am-noon, 1:00 pm-5:00 pm Monday-Friday, except holidays.

Permits will be issued with an effective date and will be valid for 72 hours. If burn is not completed within this timeframe a new permit will be required.

The area Fire Chief (or their designee) and/or the Frio County EMC will conduct an inspection of the burn site and make a recommendation to the County Judge for approval or denial of a Burn Permit.

## FRIO COUNTY OUTDOOR BURN PROCEDURES DURING A BURN BAN

### **Exception for Prescribed Burn**

Outdoor burning shall be authorized for:

(1) Prescribed burning for forest, range and wildland/wildlife management, and wildfire hazard mitigation purposes, with the exception of coastal salt-marsh management burning. Such burning shall be subject to the requirements of §111.219 of this title (relating to General Requirements for Allowable Outdoor Burning), and structures containing sensitive receptors must not be negatively affected by the burn. When possible, notification of intent to burn should be made to the appropriate commission regional office prior to the proposed burn. Commission notification or approval is not required.

## **General Requirements for Allowable Outdoor Burning**

- (1) Prior to prescribed or controlled burning for forest management purposes, the Texas Forest Service shall be notified. (see attached contact list)
- (2) Burning must be outside the corporate limits of a city or town except where the incorporated city or town has enacted ordinances which permit burning consistent with the Texas Clean Air Act, Subchapter E, Authority of Local Governments.
- (3) Burning shall be commenced and conducted only when wind direction and other meteorological conditions are such that smoke and other pollutants will not cause adverse effects to any public road, landing strip, navigable water, or off-site structure containing sensitive receptor(s).

- (4) If at any time the burning causes or may tend to cause smoke to blow onto or across a road or highway, it is the responsibility of the person initiating the burn to post flag-persons on affected roads.
- (5) Burning must be conducted downwind of or at least 300 feet (90 meters) from any structure containing sensitive receptors located on adjacent properties unless prior written approval is obtained from the adjacent occupant with possessory control.
- (6) Burning shall be conducted in compliance with the following meteorological and timing considerations:
- (A) The initiation of burning shall commence no earlier than one hour after sunrise. Burning shall be completed on the same day not later than one hour before sunset—Official sunrise/sunset as set forth in the United States Naval Observatory tables available from National Weather Service offices.

All burning shall be attended by a responsible party at all times during the active burn phase when

the fire is progressing. Arrangements can be made to have a fire department on stand-by. In cases where residual fires and/or smoldering objects continue to emit smoke after this time, such areas shall be extinguished if the smoke from these areas has the potential to create a nuisance or traffic hazard condition. *In no* case shall the extent of the burn area be allowed to increase after this time.

- (B) Burning shall not be commenced when surface wind speed is predicted to be less than 6 miles per hour (mph) (5 knots) or greater than 12 mph (10.4 knots) or with a relative humidity less than 20% during the burn period.
- (C) Burning shall not be conducted during periods of actual or predicted persistent low level atmospheric temperature inversions.

(7) Electrical insulation, treated lumber, plastics, non-wood construction/demolition materials, heavy oils, asphaltic materials, potentially explosive materials, chemical wastes, and items containing natural or synthetic rubber must not be burned.

### Responsibility for Consequences of Outdoor Burning

The authority to conduct outdoor burning under this regulation does not exempt or excuse any person responsible from the consequences, damages, or injuries resulting from the burning and does not exempt or excuse anyone from complying with all other applicable laws or ordinances, regulations, and orders of governmental entities having jurisdiction, even though the burning is otherwise conducted in compliance with this regulation.

#### **Frio County Requirements**

#### Prescribed Burn - Burn Plan:

A written burn plan should at minimum include the following:

- Purpose of the burn
- Prescribed burn manager information
- Burn site information (location, directions, etc.)
- Personnel requirements for conducting the burn
- A description of areas to be burned (fuel types, typography and previous treatments, number of acres to be burned, etc.)
- Preburn factors (fireguards, pumpers, crew size, tools and equipment, weather monitors, smoke sensitive areas, special precautions, etc.)
- Safety and contingency plans addressing smoke intrusions
- A detailed notification list that includes notification requirements for: the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality, local law enforcement, local emergency coordinator, neighbors, local volunteer fire department, and/or other appropriate entities
- A "Burn/Do Not Burn Checklist"
- Demonstration of fire suppression ability, proving the ability to have proper fire suppression equipment and manpower to manage the burn

#### Other Burns:

A written burn plan may be required for other burns. A method of controlling/containing the burn may be required.

## FRIO COUNTY OUTDOOR BURN PROCEDURES DURING A BURN BAN

#### **Summary:**

#### **Burning requires a permit**

Apply for permit at the County Judge's office, permit will be issued for a specific timeframe, notify appropriate jurisdictions (see contact list)

Burn only in the unincorporated areas of the county

Burn only when wind is between 6-12 mph, humidity >20%

No burning during temperature inversion or air stagnation

Begin burning no earlier than 1 hour after sunrise. Burning shall be completed on the same day not later than 1 hour before sunset.

All burning shall be attended by a responsible party at all times during the active burn phase when the fire is progressing.

Post someone to flag traffic if at any time the burning causes or may tend to cause smoke to blow onto or across a road or highway

Begin or continue burning only when wind direction and other weather conditions are such that smoke and other pollutants will not present a hazard to any public road, landing strip, or navigable water (e.g. lake, river, stream or bay) or have an adverse effect on any off-site structure containing "sensitive receptors."

Keep fires downwind of, or at least 300 feet (90 meters) away, from any neighboring structure that contains sensitive receptors. This requirement may be waived only with the prior written approval of whoever owns or rents the adjacent property and either resides or conducts business there.

Electrical insulation, treated lumber, plastics, non-wood construction/demolition materials, heavy oils, asphaltic materials, potentially explosive materials, chemical wastes, and items containing natural or synthetic rubber <u>must not be burned.</u> Doing so will result in extinguishment of the fire and a citation issued by law enforcement.

You or your authorized representative are responsible for the consequences, damages or injuries resulting from the burning and you are not exempt or excused from complying with all

other applicable laws or ordinances, regulations and orders of governmental entities having jurisdiction.

1.	All TECQ requirements must be met.
2.	The weather in the day of the burn as well as the forecasted weather for the next day must meet the following requirements:
	A. The minimum relative humidity (Rh) must be 20% or above. The (Rh)forecasted for the day after the burn must be 20% or above.
	B. The maximum wind speed allowed will be 12 miles per hour and forecasted wind speed on the day and any day after the burn cannot exceed 12 mph. The minimum wind speed on the day of the burn must be 6 miles per hour.
	<ul> <li>C. Burning shall not be conducted during periods of actual or predicted persistent low level atmospheric temperature inversions.</li> </ul>
3.	Being burning no earlier than one (1) hour after sunrise, end it the same day one (1) hour before sunset. Burning during temperature inversion or air stagnation advisors is prohibited. Burning is prohibited on any designated <b>Red Flag Day.</b>

7.	<u>burn plan.</u> A written prescribe burn plan must be approved by either the NRCS or a Certified Prescribed Burn Manager.
