The following conditions must be met on the day of the burn						

- 1. All TECQ requirements must be met.
- 2. The weather in the day of the burn as well as the forecasted weather for the next day must meet the following requirements:
 - A. The minimum relative humidity (Rh) must be above 30%. The (Rh)forecasted for the day after the burn must be above 30%.
 - B. The maximum wind speed allowed will be **20 mile** per hour and forecasted wind speed on the day and any day after the burn **CANNOT exceed 20 mph.** The minimum wind speed on the day of the burn must 6 miles per hour.
 - C. The maximum air temperature at the start of the burn cannot exceed 85-degree F.
- 3. Being burning no earlier than one (1) hour after sunrise, end it the same day one (1) hour before sunset. Burning during temperature inversion or air stagnation advisors is prohibited. Burning is prohibited on any designated **Red Flag Day.**

NOTE: Weather can be obtained from National Weather Services at (361) 289-0959 or in the internet at www.srh.noaa.gov/crp/ or www.tamu.edu/ticc/ for Red Flag Day information.

- 4. All dozer piles must have a line down to mineral soil at least 8 feet wide and be located a distance of 3times the height of the piles. All pasture and woodland burning must have lines constructed around the burn unit. These lines must be a minimum of 8 feet, wide, down to mineral soil and surround the burn unit.
- 5. During all burning, a mobile water system capable of holding a pumping a minimum of 100 gallons of water must be on site. If available, equipment such as a tractor and disc, dozer or road grader may be used in place of a mobile water system.
- 6. **No lightning or feeding of piles after 1:00p.m**. The exception will be lightning of prescribe burns of rangeland, agricultural fields or woodland that are accompanied by written and approved prescribed burn plan.
- 7. A written prescribe burn plan must be approved by either the NRCS, a Certified Prescribed Burn Manager, or by a representative of the Nature Conservancy, as evidence by their signature below.
