Frio County will conduct two public hearings on Monday, September 15, 2014 and on Monday, September 22, 2014 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of Frio County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 21.325 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of .5968 for each \$100 of taxable value was 9,289,807.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of <u>.5968</u> for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is <u>11,069,746</u>.
