County User Guide

What is StayALERT?

StayALERT is a bilingual, confidential website, e-mail, phone and texting avenue for county employees to confidentially report workplace safety concerns, illegal activity and concerns related to employee and public safety. Users may report concerns 24-7-365 via the StayALERT website, e-mail, phone call to a recorded and monitored line or via a text message from a cell phone. Users have the option to maintain their anonymity for all reports submitted to StayALERT.

County Participation

As a participating StayALERT Member, you as a key county stakeholder can offer a safe, confidential or anonymous reporting tool for your employees. StayALERT is a means to promote and encourage county safety. Please note that StayALERT is not a counseling hotline or means for reporting an emergency. If a safety concern is an emergency, users should dial 911.

Report Handling

All reports are received by a StayALERT On-Duty Monitor. Each On-Duty Monitor is trained to gather as much information as possible from the reporter to help facilitate county follow-up. Information is shared verbatim with the pre-designated county official who will be in charge of handling according to county protocol and procedures.

My Role as an Key County Stakeholder

As a key county stakeholder, report information may be shared with you internally. We encourage all follow-up to StayALERT reports to be handled in a timely manner in order to best address reported safety concerns and to help validate StayALERT as a useful and viable tool for promoting county safety. As a key county stakeholder, it is also critical that you promote the existence of StayALERT at your county so that employees are aware. Talk about StayALERT, hold staff meetings, pass out promotional materials, display posters and signage, etc.
