

Official retirement!!!!

After just over ten years of working as the Frio County Elections Administrator, On December 4, 2023, Carlos Segura formally submitted his resignation to the Frio County Elections Commission effective the end of the month, (end of the year), 5:00 PM December 29, 2023.

(Actually, he applied for *deferred or postponed retirement* under the county's retirement system, which would postpone the beginning date of his retirement).

Two weeks later, on December 19, 2023, the Frio County Election Commission formally met, and upon the recommendation of Mr. Segura, Assistant Sylvia Santos was appointed by unanimous decision to fill the vacancy effective December 29, 2023, at 5:00 PM.

The Frio County Elections Commission is composed of Frio County Judge Rochelle Camacho, Frio County Clerk Aaron Ibarra, Frio County Tax Assessor-Collector Anna Alaniz, Frio County Democratic Chair Reynaldo Trevino, and Frio County Republican Chair Nathan Rodriguez.

Sylvia Santos brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to the Elections Administrator position with over eight years of experience as the Assistant Administrator. The election team includes Assistant Daniella Perez, who has received commendations from the Secretary of State for Voter Registration and Election process and recognition from the Texas League of Women Voters for outstanding website addressing presidential election information.
